

CAMPSITE REGULATION

Dear camping enthusiasts!

We are delighted to welcome you to our campsite and wish you a pleasant stay. Our campsite operates from April 1st until 30th of October. Services and assistance to guests will be provided by the campsite team. Do not hesitate to contact our team at any time!

To ensure a pleasant and relaxing stay, we kindly ask you to observe our regulations.

1. ARRIVAL

The access to the campsite will be permitted after the registration at the front desk. Due to local reporting obligation we will ask for your picture ID upon registration. The obligation also applies to short term visitors. Unaccompanied children till the age of sixteen needs to provide a written consent of their legal guardian. Onboard liquid gas units require an inspection certificate. Individuals with infectious diseases will not be accommodated. With the act of registration our guest declares disease-free and the compliance of our campsite regulation.

2. GUESTS

One-day visitors are required to register at the front desk. The current prices apply.

3. VEHICLES

Cars and motorbikes have to park next tents or caravans. Wrong parking may disrupt traffic or neighbors. We only allow one vehicle per pitch. Any further vehicles can be parked at the assigned parking area. The speed limit on our campsite is 10km/h (6mph).

4. NOISE

Please consider other guests and avoid excess noise. Especially radios, televisions, stereo equipment and instruments are expected to utilize in an appropriate manner.

5. NIGHT'S REST

From 12pm to 2pm and between 10pm and 8am we keep rest time. During this period there will be no driving allowed on the property. Guests can park any vehicles at the assigned parking areas outside the campsite and use the pedestrian entrance during this time. Activities causing noise are not allowed during the rest time.

6. SECURITY/POTENTIAL HAZARDS

Building railings or trenches is not allowed. Make sure nobody can be injured by pickets, ropes or any other equipment. Label potential hazards with visible markings.

7. CLEANLINESS

Sanitary facilities: Please do not access the sanitary facilities with outdoor footwear. Leave the facilities clean and neat. The access for children below the age of six requires the company of an adult.

Barbecue area: After a barbecue the grillage requires an immediate cleaning as well as the entire barbecue area.

8. WASTE DISPOSALS

Our waste concept is based on ecological principles. Waste has to be separated and stored in the assigned containers. Garbage bags need to be fastened with knots and stored in containers as well.

9. BARBECUES/CAMPFIRE

Campfire and any sort of open fire are prohibited at the property. Barbecue is only allowed at the assigned areas. Fire and embers need to be supervised at any time. On elevated wildfire risk the management might declare a temporary barbecue prohibition. Smoking is only allowed at your own pitch and at the assigned areas.

10. DAMAGES

The cause of damages at the property and associated equipment takes full liability. We assume no liability for damages or theft of guest ownership as well as accidents and injuries. A private insurance is recommended.

11. CHILDREN

For children we provide a playground. Parents need to supervise their children in a responsible manner at any time. We apply exemption from liability to damages caused by violating supervisory duties.

12. PETS

Pets also require registration and need to be leashed at all times. Furthermore, no hazards or risks should be caused by pets. Pollutions by pets should be avoided at any time or resolved promptly.

13. DOMICILIARY RIGHTS

In the exercise of domiciliary right the management is authorized to refuse admission of individuals, if it requires perpetuation for safety and regulation at the campsite. The residents permit for the campsite will be deprived for intoxicated guests.

14. DEPARTURE

Departure is until 10am. Elsewise an additional day will be charged. Please leave your pitch clean and neat.

15. PERMANENT CAMPERS/LONG TERM CAMPERS / upon requests

Electrical systems: Attached electrical systems require a DIN/VDE inspection certificate. Permanent campers might need to submit these documentations.

Electricity/Gas/Water: Gas equipment and heaters have to comply with legal regulations. The owner is responsible for maintenance at any equipment.

Security: Driving and walking on campsite tracks follow on own risk. Please check weather conditions especially during rain and snow and make sure tracks can be used in a secure manner. Tracks cannot be cleared at all times.

Miscellaneous: Structural modifications to caravans or further equipment can only be done with written confirmation. Tree maintenance requires consultation with the management.
